### ABOUT US:

**Shiksharth** is a not-for-profit organisation developing contextual and comprehensive positive childhood experiences for children coming from spaces of conflict and adverse geography by strengthening classroom instruction, community engagement and system support in an integrated approach. Currently we are based out of the tribal Chhattisgarh in Sukma district and Bastar division of Chhattisgarh in collaboration with the local administration.

Shiksharth has been working in Sukma since 2015 with proximity of problem in an immersive mode. Among various pressing issues, we decided to get engaged with fundamental educative challenge in tribal areas i.e. difference between – medium of instruction (Hindi) in school and children's mother tongue and authorized state curriculum, content and context of children while we also address the issue of safe spaces for children who are traumatized by the ongoing violence in their daily lives.

Shiksharth at the core believes in community led model of education and is currently working on ways by which community, its wisdom, culture and customs can be contextually incorporated in classrooms content and pedagogy.

The model is an amalgamation of pedagogy, community and systemic solutions with children at the centre.

Currently we are serving 8000 children in 140 schools, 25 Gram Panchayat We have existing partnership with local administration and SCERT, Chhattisgarh to do all of this for the region and take up our solution for more than 2 lakh children in the region

We have served over 50000 children (15000 directly and 30000+ indirectly ) in the tribal region in last 5 years and have been working on different ways to support contextual learning journey of children through actions research and now we are working to present it as an offering to scale up the impact and solutions in rural and tribal areas. As part of the next phase of our journey we intend to serve children outside Sukma as well by providing them replicable solutions.

And to do this we are developing contextually relevant "comprehensive education solutions" for children from spaces of conflict and adversity by strengthening pedagogy, systems and community in an integrated approach. These solutions will ensure that we are able to take

our current reach of 15000 children to over 5,00,000 children in other tribal areas of the country.
