Rocket Learning focuses on providing foundational learning and early childhood education to children through engaging parents in learning.

We are currently looking for a program manager to drive key projects in early childhood education across 5 states, and lead our field operations and state data operations. The manager will report directly to our state lead and help manage several team members. Key tasks will include liaisoning with government and other orgs, managing teacher trainings and meetings, collecting and making data based decisions, working with Rocket functional teams (content, media, tech, etc), conducting research, etc.
