

# Position: Short Term Consultant (STC), Scaling City Institutions for India: Sanitation (SCI-FI)

## About the Project

Sanitation programme at the Centre for Policy Research (CPR) is a multi-disciplinary research, outreach and policy support initiative. The programme seeks to improve the understanding of the reasons for poor sanitation, and to examine how these might be related to technology and service delivery models, institutions, governance and financial issues, and socio-economic dimensions. Based on research findings, it seeks to support national, state and city authorities develop policies and programmes for intervention with the goal of increasing access to inclusive, safe and sustainable sanitation. Initiated in 2013, the programme is primarily funded by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF).

### **Description of responsibilities**

We are looking to engage a person for three months (from February'20 to April'20). This position will involve research and programmatic support in project locations on issues related to affordable housing in urban context in India. This will entail reviewing policies, preparing detailed summaries of academic papers, examining case studies, and emerging global best practices in the urban housing sector.

- A minimum of 0-3 years of professional experience in the development sector, preferably in urban housing sector.
- Master's in Urban Planning or Social Sciences or Public Policy or any other relevant field.

- Ability to engage in qualitative and quantitative data collation and analysis
- Excellent writing skills and ability to document the key process involved in success of interventions
